Idaho Legislative Experience

Idaho State Representative 2004-2006. District 16B elected Representative for one term. *Who says a Freshman legislator can't get things done? Check out what Jana Kemp did in one term.*

Researched and Recommended \$25M in cost savings in the Department of Health and Welfare to the House Health and Welfare Committee – 2005.
